

March 10, 2022

Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Carolyn Jolitz, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 2 in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from February were approved as read.

Roads.

Supervisor Stefl reported he met with County Highway Department reference snow plow damage at Leopolis and Weasal Dam and also Leopolis Road potholes. Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Stefl seconded to have Shawano County Highway Department do snow plow damage repair and fill potholes but requested separate billing. Motion Carried.

Chairman Jolitz reported Meverdin will do Leopolis Road culvert replacements with culverts coming from Volm.

Spring Weight Limits will be placed next week. Phil Lang Jr. and Chairman Jolitz will place signs to the south on the 14th and Supervisor Trinko will place signs north of Hwy 29 on 19 March.

Chairman Jolitz gave SchoolHouse Road Bridge and Ball Park Road updates. Shawano Highway Department Grant Bystol expects work to commence no earlier than 2023 but more likely 2024. Clerk Rigsby will find out if we are paid at receipt of bill or after we pay for Ball Park Road resurfacing. Chairman Jolitz also reported the County will do this year's bridge inspections.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Town of Seneca Ordinance 2022-01 (Ordinance Requiring Payment of Local Claims as Condition of Obtaining or Renewing Town Issued Licenses). Motion Carried.

Decision on Disposal of Town Hall Fuel Oil Furnace and Used Fuel Oil in Preparation for Installation of New LP Furnace tabled till next meeting.

Board decided to retain Luke Onesti Services for Town Hall, Town Shed and Overflow Parking Lot Lawn Mowing and Trimming from May 15th 2022 – October 15th 2022 Contract. Board requested to confirm whether there would be a fuel surcharge given the recent increase in fuel prices.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Stefl seconded to use A-1 Exterminators for pest control with both a Spring and Fall service costing approximately \$95-100 each time. Motion carried.

Supervisor Stefl brought up Town Hall parking lot snow plowing concerns. Discussion followed with the decision to use Gary Paiser Snowplowing to place salt in the future.

Chairman Jolitz gave an Ambulance Meeting update.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update.

Chairman Jolitz reported Shawano County Unit meeting attendance.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Public Input.

Shawano County Supervisor Jerry Erdmann provided County update to include vehicle purchases instead of leasing and Planning and Zoning reorganization.

Chairman Jolitz adjourned the meeting at 6:50 PM.
