

September 15, 2021

Meeting opened at 5:45 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 8 in attendance with Clerk Raymond Rigsby arriving after the meeting started.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from August were approved as read.

Roads.

Supervisor Jolitz reported that the culvert on Fish Hatchery Road was replaced. One Bridge dip on Roosevelt Road and two on North Branch Road were repaired with wedge over lay. Brushing on Leopoldis Road will be completed later this fall. Roosevelt Road blacktop was completed but MCC will need to complete shouldering and seeding by culverts. Finally, Marosevec will patch Town roads in October.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to nominate Carolyn Jolitz to fill the vacant Town Chairman Position beginning 1 October 2021. Motion Carried. Clerk will post notice for Supervisor 2 position vacancy.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance Meeting update to include, new Director (2) along with staff hired and that the assessment increase will be \$33 per person for 2022.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update to include ongoing maintenance issues and that income has improved with increase in Fire Protection charges.

Board had a discussion on ARPA Money and expenditure options. No action taken.

Town Facilities Update included Treasurer Voelz reporting the purchase of 4 tables at \$938.70, sand blasting of side of the Town Hall will happen, repair of doors and latches on Town Shed and replacement of loud fan in men's bathroom and toilet with high rise toilet in women's.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Public Input.

Harvey Stefl mentioned an issue with work done by Scots Construction. Board understood Scot's will come back in the fall to fix.

Chairman Nordwig adjourned the meeting at 6:31 PM.
