

TOWN FACILITY UPDATE

In 2024, Several projects were completed on the Town Hall to include:

- The Town Hall's outside wall was painted following extensive work in 2023.
- LED lights were installed in the Hall replacing inefficient lighting.

ROAD PROJECTS

In 2024, in addition to normal maintenance the Town completed the following major projects:

- **Patching** was completed on **Hatchery Road** and **Campground Road** from County Road G towards Bratz Lane. **Rock Road** from County Road G southwas resurfaced to the box bridge. **Weasel Dam Road** had a boulder removed and patched in a couple areas.

- **Culvert** work was completed on **Old 29** with patching to be redone Spring 2025 due to dip. Culvert was replaced on **Schoolhouse Road** corner North Branch. Finally, two culverts were replaced on **Airport Road** with patching completed.

- We were unable to do brushing due to vendor being unavailable this year.

- **Gravel** was added to the following roads: **Deer Lane, Townline Road, Swamp Lane, Poplar Lane** and **Buckoski Lane**.

- The Town paid off the our AbbyBank Loan for Ball Park Road with no increase in property taxes dues to the Town being reimbursed for 90% of the cost.

- During our November 2024 regular meeting the Seneca Town Board signed a Leopolis Road Maintenance Agreement with the Town of Grant outlining maintenance responsibility for Leopolis Road.

FUTURE ANTICIPATED PROJECTS

In 2025, in addition to normal maintenance the Town expects to execute the following major projects:

- Engineering work is almost complete for **School House Road Bridge** with 100% State & Federal Government construction funding provided. Construction is slated for July 2025.

- **Leopolis Road** from Swamp Lane to County Road G has been submitted as the Town's LRIP project with construction possibly starting in the Fall of 2025.

- Brushing for 2025 will focus on School House Road and Hatchery Road.

OTHER UPDATES

Thanks to Stockbridge-Munsee Tribe for donating the full cost to purchase a new ambulance to Tigerton Ambulance Association.

Reminder that we follow Shawano County when placing Spring Weight Limits but when taking the limits off the Town observes local frost levels which usually last one to two weeks after Shawano County. Also, if you notice something such as a road sign down, a tree down, the road washed out or culverts down, please report it to the Town Board.

This year property owners will see a yearly fee of \$260.00 for garbage and recycling service.

On Saturday, September 13, 2025 the Town will be offering free disposal of electronics to all Town of Seneca residents. From 9 am to Noon - Please no "early" drop offs. A waste container will be parked at the Town Hall parking lot. Proof of residency will be required. Electronics accepted are TV's, VCR's, Microwaves, DVD Players, Computers and computer components. No large appliances or items containing Freon accepted.
