Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 3 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from June were approved as read.

Roads.

Supervisor Jolitz gave Roosevelt Road update to include all culverts were replaced, Curb and Gutter will be required and leveling will need to be done before paving. Complete Services has begun shoulder brushing. Scott Construction will pulverize, grade, cold mix part of Weasel Dam at a cost of \$3,500 with Meverdin replacing one culvert. Farhner is scheduled to do crack filling end of August. Supervisor Jolitz reported that signs were replaced on Roosevelt Road and ATV/UTV sign on Cty G removed by Harvey Stefl.

Board discussed Campground Road Speed limit reduction request and legal requirement to complete engineering and traffic control study. Discussion centered on unknown cost to conduct said study and that results may be to have speed limit remain same or decrease. Board decided to look at placing additional signs to alert motorist of need to take caution.

Board directed that Ordinance 2018-01 ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES be amended to add Rock Road and Zimdars Road as open ATV/UTV routes with amended ordinance presented to Board at August meeting.

Supervisor Jolitz reported Perry Seamless had placed gutters on Town Hall for \$2,104.00 with sandblasting to be done next.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance Meeting update.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Superintendent Glenda Butterfield, Bowler School District introduced herself and gave school updates.

Phil Lang Jr reported he would remove the sand from the parking lot.
