Chairman Carolyn Jolitz, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Eugene Asenbrenner, Ellen Asenbrenner, Larry Gast, and Phil Lang Jr in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led the pledge of allegiance.

Chairman Jolitz was selected to chair the meeting and called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

2024 Annual Meeting minutes were presented by Clerk Raymond Rigsby. Raymond Rigsby motioned and Harvey Stefl seconded to approve as read. Motion Carried.

Clerk Raymond Rigsby presented the 2024 Annual Financial Statement with several points highlighted. Greg Nordwig motioned and Larry Gast seconded to approve as read. Motion Carried.

Clerk Rigsby gave a municipality wage comparison layout. Greg Nordwig motioned and Barbara Rigsby seconded to approve a 30% pay raise for Board members with a recurring annual 5% cost of living increase going forward. Raise would be effective in the 2027 election year. Motion Carried

Chairman Jolitz gave a Chairman's update. In 2024, Several projects were completed on the Town Hall to include the outside wall being painted and LED lights installed in the Hall.

In 2024, in addition to normal maintenance the Town completed the following major projects:

Patching was completed on **Hatchery Road** and **Campground Road** from County Road G towards Bratz Lane. **Rock Road** from County Road G south was resurfaced to the box bridge. **Weasel Dam Road** had a boulder removed and patched in a couple areas.

Culvert work was completed on **Old 29** with patching to be redone Spring 2025 due to dip. Culvert was replaced on **Schoolhouse Road** corner North Branch. Finally, two culverts were replaced on **Airport Road** with patching completed.

Gravel was added to the following roads: **Deer Lane, Townline Road, Swamp Lane, Poplar Lane** and **Buckoski Lane**.

The Town paid off our AbbyBank Loan for Ball Park Road with no increase in property taxes due to the Town being reimbursed for 90% of the cost.

During our November 2024 regular meeting the Seneca Town Board signed a Leopold Road Maintenance Agreement with the Town of Grant outlining maintenance responsibility for Leopold Road.

In 2025, in addition to normal maintenance the Town expects to execute the following major projects:

Engineering work is almost complete for **School House Road Bridge** with 100% State & Federal Government construction funding provided. Construction is slated for July 2025.

Leopolis Road from Swamp Lane to County Road G has been submitted as the Town's LRIP project with construction possibly starting in the Fall of 2025. Brushing for 2025 will focus on School House Road and Hatchery Road.

Spring road inspections are set for 7:30 on 19 April 2025.

Chairman Jolitz reported signs for Cty D transition zone were installed. Larry Gast asked if the County could put flags up on the new signs.

Chairman Jolitz gave a facilities update with the outside wall being painted and LED lights installed.

Chairman Jolitz gave an Ambulance meeting update. The new ambulance to be purchased by Stock-Bridge Munsee Tribe should arrive in December. TAA needs EMTs and PERCAP will go up for 2026.

Supervisor Stefl gave Tilleda Pond District meeting updates to no levy planned.

Chairman Jolitz reported no action could be taken by the DA for the illegal tire dumping on Mill Creek Road.

Public Input.

Phil Lang Jr asked about effort to beautify the community. Larry Gast said he would help lead the effort.

Sherry Voelz made a motion and Barbara Rigsby seconded it to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM.
