Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Carolyn Jolitz, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 2 in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from March were approved as read.

Roads.

Chairman Jolitz gave a roads update to include Town's ARIP grant award in the amount of \$810,000 for 2 miles of School House Road. The Board discussed getting engineering done for both School House and North Branch in order to begin work late summer early fall at the latest. Chairman Jolitz will speak to Mary Nordin. Clerk Rigsby reported asking County for loan to cover the costs for both projects until Town gets reimbursement after the project is complete. Supervisor Stefl reiterated the road was to be engineered for 22 feet. Morasevec is on schedule to do brushing and pothole filling. Supervisor Trinko reported he would look into removal of the large tree on Leopolis Road west of the Rosenows. Chairman Jolitz reported she had heard no issues with storm response and thanked all who helped. Supervisor Stef reported he received the Carpenter's fire number on Cty D. Chairman Jolitz will contact Scots in order to get in on Town of Grants June work and have 1.1 mile of Leopolis Road double chipped sealed at the same time.

Chairman Jolitz reported Mr Dallas on Maple Lane will install a culvert. Chairman Jolitz reported she had reached out to Grant Bystol, Shawano County Highway Commissioner, reference start date for Cty Rd D Bridge replacement. Clerk Rigsby reported receipt of \$11K reimbursement check from Highway Department for School House Road Bridge. Clerk Rigsby reported April 29 Highway Department Annual Meeting and that the Town Board was invited. County Weight Limits come off Monday, 13 April. Spring Road Inspection are 18 April at 8AM then Board will decide on Town's weight limits coming off. Supervisor Trinko will put up new weight limit signs on Rock Road at that time.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl to Approve Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map #842 Volume 3 Page 187 as Document #420800 and part of the SE1/4 SW1/4, Section 13, T27N-R13E, Town of Seneca, Shawano County, Wisconsin for Wayne and Debra Brady, owners. Motion Carried.

Clerk was directed to send courtesy letters to property owners off the intersection of Roosevelt Road and Mill Creek and also Leopolis and Cty G for zoning / nuisance issues.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl to Approve \$7,077.64 Wisconsin Emergency Management Wisconsin Disaster Fund Application. Motion Carried.

Chairman Jolitz gave an Ambulance Meeting update to include new ambulance will be received Wednesday March 18, 2026 and finances are in the green at this point of the year.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update to include air tank systems are \$4K and they will order 2 plus a let out suit.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Facility update. Issue with emergency lights in the Hall was reported.

Public Input. Rachel Janda asked about when weight limits will come off on Cty Rd D. Board reported Monday

Chairman Jolitz adjourned the meeting at 6:31 PM.
