Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from July were approved as read.

Roads.

Town received two estimates (Shawano County - \$24,000+ and Meverden - \$5,500 plus materials) to repair culvert issues on West Seneca. Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to accept Meverden to do work at a cost of \$5,500 with Town purchasing material from Volm at a cost of \$6,263.21. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Jolitz reported brush cutting would begin in next two weeks and that pothole filling was on-going.

Supervisor Jolitz provided update on Roosevelt Road Grinding Project.

Supervisor Jolitz thanked those who helped clear the roads during recent storms.

Phil Lang Jr asked about brush work needed at Intersection of Airport and Roosevelt. Supervisor Trinko said he would look at.

Clerk reported Fall electronics turn in is 14 Sep 19 from 9AM-12PM. Phil Lang Jr will supervise and Clerk will assist and post notices.

Supervisor Jolitz reported need to continue to report Shawano County Health, Junk & Environmental Hazard Ordinance Violations at N6191 Pond Lane. No foreseeable action by the County.

Supervisor Jolitz provided update on County working with property owner to complete cleanup of Rosenow Properties.

Supervisor Jolitz provided Tilleda Pond District meeting update.

Cemetery Certified Cemetery Map tabled.

Clerk Rigsby reported need to get landowner refusal for ATV / UTV trails and then submit application to County to open up Cty Road G from Campground Road to Ballpark for ATV / UTV use. Board recommended approval and directed the Clerk to submit the paperwork. Clerk Rigsby also reported Mary Wright offered to pay county fee. Clerk Rigsby will start process to submit request.

Board requested that Harvey Stefl put signs up on Campground Road. Harvey Stefl also mentioned large truck parking on Town Property.

Supervisor Jolitz provided Bertram Communications Broadband effort update with Gresham Tower expected to go "hot" in September.
