Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Jolitz, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 2 in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from November were approved as amended

Roads.

Chairman Jolitz gave a roads update to include our submission of the 1 Mile of North Branch LRIP packet being selected for \$113,083. She also reported ARIP packet for 1 mile of School House efforts to get that submitted by 15 December. Supervisor Stefl reported Butternut Lane will be plowed by County instead of Town of Grant as previously agreed. Chairman Jolitz discussed issue with plowing gravel roads and lack of deep freeze and impact on road. Said they will get plowed by smaller truck when surface and subsurface is ready

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to Recommend Approval of Conditional Use Permit Request from Benishek Properties in order to Permit Indoor Retail Sales (Vintage Resale Store) in an OAR zoned parcel. Parcel (formally the Bethany Church) site address is W12902 State Hwy 29, Tilleda, WI. Motion carried 3 Aye, 0 No.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve List of Candidates to be Election Workers for the Town of Seneca for FY 2026-2027. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Terry Watters Second Driveway Application Request. After a review of recent correspondence from Mr Watters and the fact that his adjoining parcels were 39.97 acres and not the required 40 acres in accordance with Amended Ordinance #4-06 which would allow him two driveways, the Board agreed to approve this request. Clerk Rigsby will send a letter informing him.

Jolitz gave an Ambulance Meeting update to include new ambulance expected soon and payroll was paid.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Chairman Jolitz seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Facility update. Custodian Voelz will coordinate Town Hall snowplowing with Hartleben and shoveling with Phil Lang Jr.
