Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Jolitz, Supervisor Stefl, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 1 in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from January were approved as read.

Roads.

Chairman Jolitz gave a roads update to include our ARIP 90/10 packet for 1 mile of School House is submitted with decision expected to be made in March. Supervisor Stefl reported he would have Paiser plow gravel roads in spring as needed when roads thaw. Chairman Jolitz discussed bridge replacement on Cty D coming into Tilleda from Highway 29 and alternate route planned by the County. She will let the County know they can route down Ball Park. Given concerns about Rock Road being used to bypass alternate route, Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Stefl seconded to place 7-ton weight limit on Rock Road from Spring Thaw thru end of July due to special conditions of bridge construction on County Road D. Motion Carried. Supervisor Stefl reported on his attempt to engage a vendor listed in the WTA magazine to do brush company with no success.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Certified Survey Map for Wayne and Debra Brady creating two separate parcels out parcel #042-14430-0000, SW1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 14, T27N-R13E, Town of Seneca, Shawano County in order to create a 10-acre Lot on Ballpark Road. Motion Passed. Mike Hoffman also informed the Board that the Brady's were looking at change the parcels where their house was to create a new, larger lot with a 33' easement. More to follow.

Chairman Jolitz and Supervisor Stefl will attend WTA sponsored BOR training. Clerk Rigsby will attend WTA Unit meeting in Belle Plaine

Chairman Jolitz gave an Ambulance Meeting update to include new ambulance has not been received and finances are in the green at this point of the year.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update to include purchase of new radios, 3-4 air tank systems and that the equipment fund is at \$31K.

Supervisor Stefl gave a Pond District meeting update to include no insurance on the dam and \$86K in account.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Facility update. Propane was at 50%. February and March snowplowing will include around Town Shed.
