Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 6 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from June were approved as amended.

Roads.

Chairman Nordwig reported he conducted site visit to Roger Jolitz's property in reference to culvert issues and gave him guidance to bring the culvert into compliance with Town's Ordinance. Chairman Nordwig discussed LRIP funds availability and stated he would call Grant Bystol at the County Hwy Dept.

Supervisor Jolitz reported shoulder mowing has been completed. Board reported that Box Culvert on Ball Park Road would not have to be replaced according to report from Nordin and Associates. Further Nordin is working up details for Ball Park Road construction.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to award Crack Filling Contract to Fahrner for Town Hall Parking Lot and Weasel Dam Road. Work on Airport Road, Mill Creek Road, Campground Road, Zimdars Road, and Paiser Lane delayed until funds are available. Motion Carried. Further Board directed Supervisor Jolitz to contact Fahrner and sign contract to commence work.

Supervisor Trinko reported issues with culvert on Mill Creek Road with Clerk sending letter out with suspense of 15 Sep 20 to correct.

No action taken on Frontier Communications Permit to place Fiber Optic along Town Right of Ways on Roosevelt Road and Ball Park Road as contractor has not contacted Board for walk through.

Supervisor Jolitz motioned and Supervisor Trinko seconded to approve agreement under the 2020 HAVA Coronavirus Air, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Subgrant Program. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve Variance for Ronald E. Zimdars (C/O Thomas and Charlotte Brandenburg) to divide the property at W12774 Zimdars Road, Tilleda, creating two parcels resulting in one of the two parcels being only 1.504 acres instead of the minimum 2 acres required by the Town of Seneca Land Division Ordinance. No objectors were present. Motion Carried.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance meeting update to include issues with backup coverage to Wittenberg.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update with changes to fees for Towns still being considered.

Supervisor Jolitz gave a Tilleda Pond District update to include District is looking for new insurance and annual meeting is 27 July 2020.

Supervisor Jolitz made a motion and Supervisor Trinko seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

County Supervisor Erdman gave County update to include upcoming 2nd Amendment Sanctuary City Meeting on 22nd July 2020 at 3PM.

Shawano County District Attorney position Candidate Aaron Damrau introduced himself to the Board and plans if elected.
