

June 11, 2020

Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 7 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from May were approved as read.

Roads.

Supervisor Jolitz reported mowing would begin prior to 4th of July and gravel work has been completed. Chairman Nordwig will contact Casper High about felled tree debris in the ditch on Campground Road. Chairman Nordwig brought up crack filling and given Harvey Stefls recommendation Supervisor Jolitz will contact Farhner to do work.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve Liquor License Applications for Town of Seneca. Motion Carried.

Census 2020 mass mailing effort discussed with no action taken.

2020 Revaluation of Property Classes tabled till September based on advice from Assessor.

Board discussed a recommendation to Tigerton Ambulance Association for Backup Ambulance Service being Shawano. Chairman Nordwig will notify TAA.

Mary Nordin, R. W Nordin & Associates present to discuss with Board Ballpark Road Engineering. Construction to start in 2022 with engineering and preliminary work to begin immediately. Mary Nordin said may need a DNR Wetland Delineation conducted given water on road from ditches and bridge. Chairman Nordwig will contact Shawano County Highway Dept to conduct Bridge inspection.

No action taken on Frontier Communications Permit to place Fiber Optic along Town Right of Ways on Roosevelt Road and Ball Park Road as contractor has not contacted Board for walk through.

Board met during special hearing to decide on Board's recommendation to Shawano County to approve a variance that would allow William Young's placement of a 14' x 70' single-wide manufactured home on property zoned OAR where dwellings are required to be at least 20 feet wide in the narrowest horizontal dimension. No objectors were present. Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to recommend that Shawano County issue a Variance as requested by William and Sarah Young. Board's recommendation is contingent on the Young's continued occupation of the single-wide manufactured home and if the property were sold to another entity the single-wide manufactured home would be removed. Motion Carried.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance meeting update reporting that calls are down, new ambulance delivered and intent is to auction off old ambulance.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update with changes to fees for Towns being considered.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Public Input.

Dennis Schmidt asked about use of ATV/UTV's on roads not signed as allowed. Board informed him of DNR agricultural exception.

Harvey Stefl stated that the Jolitz Weasel Dam culvert was still not in compliance with Town Ordinance. Chairman Nordwig stated he would contact the Property Owner.

Chairman Nordwig adjourned the meeting at 6:21 PM.
