Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Mike Trinko, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 7 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from October were approved as corrected.

Roads.

Supervisor Stefl brought up Campground Road blacktop and shoulder concerns. Board's conclusion is to not use County Highway Department for future blacktopping given no guarantee of work.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Stefl seconded to lock in west half of Zimdars Road construction project for 2019 at 2018 contract amounts with Northeast Asphalt Motion carried.

Discussion on getting roads fixed followed with residents offering to pursue possible funding for road work in the Town. Board took no action during meeting but directed that Clerk place discussion and decision to create Road's Funding Committee on next month's agenda.

Board tabled weight limit ordinance for next meeting and directed changes so that mailbox policy ordinance was ready for discussion and approval at next meeting.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Treasurers Bond resolution.

Supervisor Stefl gave Tilleda Pond District Meeting update.

Supervisor Trinko gave Fire meeting update and reported levy remained the same for 2019 at \$4,500.00

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance meeting update and reported that 2019 assessment would be \$20 per person.

Public Input.

Vickie Jolitz brought up her concerns about election manning numbers and website updating.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Chairman Nordwig adjourned the meeting at 7:09 PM
