Meeting opened at 5:30 with Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 5 in attendance.

Supervisor Trinko led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from October were approved as read.

Roads.

Supervisor Jolitz reported on sign down on Leopolis Road, Pothole and Brush Cutting complete for this year, need to reassess work needed in the Spring, and Zimdars road shoulder damage.

Harvey Stefl reported more vehicles parking on Town Hall property after hours. Also asked if Meverden and Sperberg billed for same work on back steps. Clerk Rigsby reported no bill received from Sperberg.

Supervisor Jolitz reported County had issued citation on Rosenow Property and that Zach Rosenow would receive a monthly citation until issue is resolved.

Ann Retzlaff asked that the Town develop and post on the website a 5-year plan for road improvements like Town of Herman has on their website. Asked that it be on the agenda next month for consideration. She also asked if her campground security guard could be appointed as constable and issue citation for nuisance dogs. Board discussed current process and that we contract for that service. Finally, she asked about Town hiring maintenance person like other Town's. Board responded with they had discussed it and it (benefits, equipment, etc) would make it cost prohibitive given our budget.
