

Oct 10, 2018

Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Mike Trinko, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 8 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from September were approved as read.

Roads.

Chairman Nordwig reported work on Zimdars almost complete with ditching and shoulder work to be finished.

Supervisor Trinko reported his concern about cost to do patching given sequencing for work by the County Highway Department.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Ordinance 2018-02 (Airport Road Speed Limit) an update to Ordinance 1-90. Motion carried.

Board will review recommended ordinances covering Mailbox Policy and Road Weight Limits.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve resolution pledging \$1500 matching contribution towards Broadband Expansion Grant effort with Shawano Economic Progress, Inc. and Bertram Communications.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve 2019 waste management fees of \$157.40 for fulltime and \$81.20 for part-time residents. Motion carried.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve increasing town levy by \$31,446.48 to pay Town's outstanding road construction debt. Motion carried.

Budget meeting is 5:15 PM on November 8, 2018.

Chairman Nordwig reported he would contact County about Town no requiring an update to the Comprehensive Plan.

Supervisor Trinko motioned Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve Schober Certified Survey Map (CSM). Motion Carried.

Fall Road inspections to commence Saturday 13 Oct 18 at 7:30. Board will review request for culvert from Terry Watters at that time.

Supervisor Stefl reported upcoming Tilleda Pond District Meeting.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance meeting update and reported possible special assessment to pay for audit of approximately \$2 per person.

Public Input.

County Chairman Jerry Erdman gave updates on Broadband, Evidence Building and Denison property.

Chairman Nordwig addressed Ann Retzlaff's concerns about pursuing theft and possible need for Town Ordinance due to inaction by County DA. Chairman Nordwig explained it would not be in best interest of Town and that Town's Attorney indicated putting continual pressure on DA was about the only option.

Larry Gast asked about working a Town Ordinance to eliminate blighted properties. Board discussed County has an ordinance and not much town can do in the matter other than steps outlined in the County Ordinance.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Chairman Nordwig adjourned the meeting at 7:12 PM
