

October 8, 2020

Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Greg Nordwig, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Carolyn Jolitz, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, and 3 in attendance.

Chairman Nordwig led saying of Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from September were approved as read.

Roads.

Chairman Nordwig reported that work on Cty Road D bridge coming into Tilleda involve putting a polymer coating on deck.

Supervisor Trinko reported snow plowing damage on Trinko Lane repaired.

Supervisor Jolitz reported grading, spraying and shoulder work was complete and that trees were removed for Campground Road right of way. Additionally, Meverdin will provide estimate to replace culvert on Weasel Dam Road.

Supervisor Trinko reported dip on Roosevelt Road bridge needs to be signed. Clerk will order signs.

Communications Permit to place Fiber Optic along Town Right of Ways on Roosevelt Road and Ball Park Road was approved and sent to the contractor for action.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to conduct a Market Update 2021 Revaluation of all Property Classes by Preuss Appraisal Service Inc for \$1,500.00 to be completed this fall. Motion Carried.

Board discussed School House Road Bridge Closure Traffic Signs and Barriers damage and response. Supervisor Trinko will ask Resident Tony Goez to place cameras up to catch future vandalism. Decision to file insurance claim will be made after receipt of bill from Shawano County. Bridge expert is expected to visit 27 Oct at 9AM at the Town Hall to discuss options for bridge repairs and/or replacement.

Supervisor Trinko motioned and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to continue increased levy limit for 2020 to be collected in 2021 to cover outstanding road construction loan. Motion Carried.

Town Board approved November 12, 2020 5 PM as date / time for Annual Budget Meeting.

Chairman Nordwig gave Ambulance meeting update. Call volume down so assessment for 2021 is to be \$23 a person up from \$21 in 2020. Tigerton Ambulance may pursue Roads to Recovery Funds thru Towns to pay wages for First Responders.

Supervisor Trinko gave a Fire Meeting update. 2% fire dues payment is outstanding. Clerk will send payment.

Fall Road Inspection is Saturday 31 Oct at 7:30 AM.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Jolitz seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Public Input.

Steve Freund reported issues with Maple Lane grading.

Town Board discussed issue with trailer on Town Hall property. Clerk will contact owner to have trailer removed.

Chairman Nordwig adjourned the meeting at 6:21 PM.
