

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. #2018-01 TO INCLUDE UPDATING SECTION III – ROUTES TO DESIGNATE ROCK ROAD AND ZIMDARS ROAD AS ROUTES NOW OPEN TO ATV/UTVS:

ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES

TOWN OF SENECA, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Section I - Intent

The Town of Seneca, Shawano County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle ordinance for the operation of all-terrain vehicles (ATV) and utility terrain vehicles (UTV) upon all designated roadways of the Township.

Section II - Statutory Authority

This ordinance is created pursuant to Town authority under section 1.1.01 as authorized by 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

Section III - Routes

The following roads in the Town of Seneca are designated as routes open to ATV/UTVs:

- A. Schoolhouse Road from intersection with North Branch Road east to Village of Bowler village limits.
- B. Campground Road from intersection with Highway 29 north to intersection with Roosevelt Road
- C. Ballpark Road from intersection with County Road D east to County Road G
- D. Bratz Lane from intersection with Campground Road east to end
- E. Leopolis Road from intersection with County D west to intersection with Weasel Dam Road
- F. Old 29 from intersection with Highway 29 east to intersection with Highway 29
- G. Roosevelt Road from intersection with North Branch Road east to Town of Herman limits
- H. Airport Road from intersection with County Road D north to Intersection with Roosevelt Road
- I. Hatchery Road from County Road D south to end

- J. Swamp Lane from intersection with Leopolis Road north to end
- K. Mill Creek Road from intersection with Roosevelt Road north to intersection with Schoolhouse Road
- L. Weasel Dam Road from intersection with Leopolis Road north to intersection with Old 29
- M. North Branch Road from intersection with Roosevelt Road north to intersection with Schoolhouse Road
- N. Nursery Lane north to intersection with County Road D
- O. Buckowski Lane north to intersection with Old 29
- P. County Road D from intersection with Hatchery Road east to intersection with Ballpark Road (35 MPH or less speed limit zone)
- Q. East Townline Road from intersection with Roosevelt north to Town limits
- R. Mill Lane from intersection with Ballpark Road north to end.
- S. Rock Road from the intersection with State Hwy 29 north to the intersection with County Road G.
- T. Zimdars Road from the intersection with County Road D west to the intersection with County Road G.

Section IV - Conditions

As a condition for the use of these designated routes, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
- B. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.
- D. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)c.
- E. All ATV/UTV operators must stay on paved portions of roads. No riding on the shoulder of roads.
- F. All ATV/UTV operators must be 16 years or older.
- G. ATV/UTVs can only be operated from 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 pm on designated Town roads.

Section V – ENFORCEMENT

The Town of Seneca Board of Supervisors gives the authority to enforce this ordinance to the State Highway Patrol, Shawano County Sheriff's Department, Stockbridge Munsee Tribal Police, Town of Seneca Chairperson and Board of Supervisors or their designee, and any other enforcement authority as allowed by Wisconsin Statutes.

This Section VI - PENALTIES

Wisconsin state All-Terrain and Utility Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis.Stats., are adopted by reference.

This Section VII - LAWS

The Town of Seneca accepts no liability for the operation of ATV/UTVs on any Town road under the provisions of this Ordinance.


Section VIII - SEVERABILITY

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.


Section IX - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication and can be reviewed by the Board at their discretion. A copy of this Ordinance and any revisions thereto, shall be sent by the Town Clerk to the Department of Natural Resources, the Shawano County Sheriff's Department and any other law enforcement agency serving in the Town of Seneca's jurisdiction.
