Meeting opened at 5:30 with Chairman Carolyn Jolitz, Supervisor Michael Trinko, Supervisor Harvey Stefl, Clerk Raymond Rigsby, Treasurer Sherry Voelz, and 1 in attendance.

Chairman Jolitz led the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for 9/11 Observance.

Minutes from August were approved as amended

Roads.

Chairman Jolitz gave a roads update. Spraying is complete and grading is on-going.

Board discussed continuing issues with School House Road and Roosevelt Road pot holes. If Complete Services can't do it then Supervisor Trinko will do it with Supervisor Stefl coordinating with Grnat Bystol at Highway for asphalt. If unable to do it then County will be asked to fill potholes.

School House, North Branch, and Trinko Lane road repairs were completed. Supervisor Trinko placed 'rough roads' signs at each end of School House Road. Chairman Jolitz asked for input on future LRIP project with School House Road and North Branch being the two options.

Leopolis Road project is ongoing with shoulder work starting 12 September.

Fall Road Inspection is scheduled for 27 September at 8AM.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve a resolution approving and authorizing an application thru the Wisconsin Board of Commissioners of Public Lands for a loan in the amount of \$350,000.00 at 5.5% interest to finance road work on Leopolis Road. A second resolution was also presented during the motion levying upon all taxable property in the Town of Seneca a direct tax to pay for the loan. Motion Carried and both Resolutions were approved by a majority vote of the members. Clerk will contact BCPL and ask about possibility of additional interest reduction and submit the application accordingly.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to allow the township to retain an attorney to handle matters and correspondence concerning Terry Watters to include but not limited to his denied request for a second driveway.

Chairman Jolitz reported her attendance at the next WTA conference in Stevens Point.

Chairman Jolitz provided an ambulance meeting update to include still expecting new ambulance in November or December.

Supervisor Trinko provided a Fire Meeting update to include next meeting plans to finalize future billing.

Supervisor Trinko made a motion and Supervisor Stefl seconded to approve bills. Motion carried.

Facility update. Supervisor Trinko reported hall north wall powerwashing was rescheduled. Propane tank is full. Supervisor Stefl reported all furnaces were inspected and fault with

thermostat was covered under warranty. Supervisor Trinko will repair hole in wall reported by Supervisor Stefl.

Public Input.

County Supervisor Trinko discussed County process for pushing through ATV/UTV ordinance.

Chairman Jolitz adjourned the meeting at 7:05 PM.
